Benefits and Conditions of application for membership

Craigmillar Adventure Project (Capro) is a leading agency in the delivery of outdoor, adventure education services to a diverse range of groups across the communities of the City of Edinburgh.

Members are represented by an elected Board of Directors who oversee the strategic direction of the organisation. Sub-committees are appointed by the Board, as necessary to progress specific pieces of work on their behalf. Sub-committees report directly to the Board.

Aims and Objectives of Capro

In accordance with article 5 of the Memorandum of Association, the Objects of the Company shall be to promote the education of the inhabitants of the area of benefit without distinction between persons on any other grounds through the provision or assistance in the provision of outdoor educational facilities and activities, in the interest of social welfare for recreation and other leisure-time occupation so that their conditions of life may be improved.

Categories of membership

No person or body shall be admitted to be a member of the Company unless her, his or its application for membership is approved by the Directors.

Full membership of the Company shall be open to:

subject to Article 9, any person who has attained the age of 18 (eighteen) years and who lives within the area of benefit of the Company and who is in agreement with the Objects, without discrimination between persons on any other grounds; and

any company or other corporate body not established for the purposes of profit which is based or operates within the area of benefit of the Company and which is in agreement with the Objects; and

subject to Articles 20 and 21, the nominee of any society, unincorporated association or trust not established for the purposes of profit which is based or operates within the area of benefit and which is in agreement with the Objects.

Subject to Article 9 **Youth Membership** of the Company shall be open to

any person aged under 18 (eighteen) who lives within the area of benefit and who supports the Objects of the Company;

Subject to Article 8 **Associate Membership** of the Company shall be open to:

subject to Article 9, any other person who has attained the age of 18 (eighteen) and who supports the Objects of the Company but who does not qualify under Article 5.1; and

any company or other corporate body not established for the purposes of profit which is in agreement with the Objects but which does not qualify under Article 5.2; and

subject to Articles 20 and 21, the nominee of any society, unincorporated association or trust not established for the purposes of profit which is in agreement with the Objects but which does not qualify under Article 5.3.

At no time shall the number of Associate Members exceed one-third of the total membership of the Company.

Voting rights

Subject to the provisions of Articles 9, 59, 62, 63 and 64 every Full and Associate Member (but not Youth Member) of the Company shall have one vote at general meetings of the Company, exercisable in person (in the case of a corporate body, by its duly authorised representative present at the meeting) or by proxy.

No member of the Company shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all monies then payable by her, him or it to the Company in the form of subscriptions or otherwise have been paid in full.

Every Youth Member shall have one vote, exercisable in person at the Annual General Meeting on business relating to the appointment or election of the Youth Advisory Committee (if any) or the appointment or election of Youth Member representatives to the Board of Directors.

No objection shall be raised to the qualification of any voter except at the meeting or adjourned meeting at which the vote objected to be tendered, and every vote not disallowed at the meeting shall be valid. Any objection made in due time shall be referred to the chairperson of the meeting whose decision shall be final and conclusive.
